RESOURCES FOR CURRENT GRAD TRANSITIONS:- **KEEP LEARNING:** This resource is designed to help students be successful with their transition to online learning at UBC while it is not possible to implement in-person sessions. <https://keeplearning.ubc.ca/>-**READY, SET, BEGIN:** This program is being set-up to help students transition to university despite interruptions in their final semester of school. -Deferring an offer of admission has always been possible and this year is not an exception. Requests for a deferral are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and priority will be given to students with extenuating circumstances that may inhibit their ability to begin their studies in September 2020.
