There's a massive teacher shortage in BC. Due to a landmark court case in 2016 they had to hire 3500 teachers. BC teachers are the lowest paid in the country. Reserve teacher list is shrinking. Multiple public schools didn't have enough teachers. Even though teachers may be certified in other provinces, they need to upgrade if working in B.C. Provincial Gov't mandates that non-certified teachers can only teach 20 days/calendar month. Public Schools are looking at hiring French teachers from France or Belgium.

Old Business:

Hot lunch program (Leigh Ann Sullivan reporting) Summer orders worked well. 88 students ordered which is a 20% increase. It helped having PayPal + hot lunches/student fees together. First order was \$1000. We have a few new suppliers this year. (Boston Pizza and Sunshine Market)
