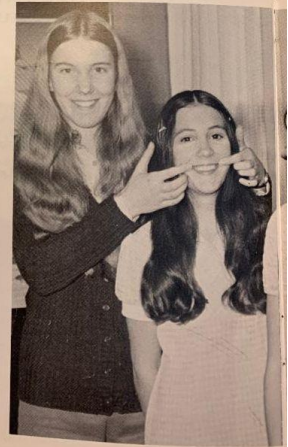

The order system will start **September 25** and will end **October 2**. *No late orders will be accepted.*

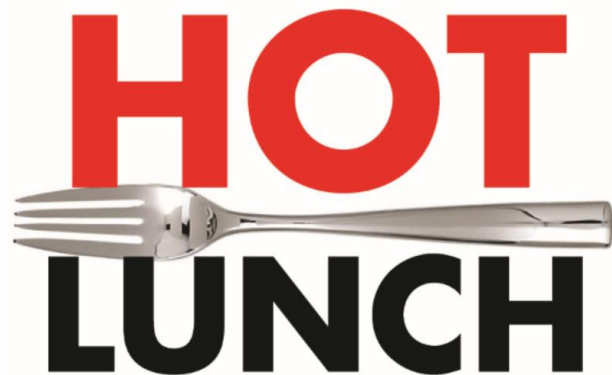
Refunds will be provided in case the school has to shut down due to covid-19. The first hot lunch will be served on October 5 until December 17.

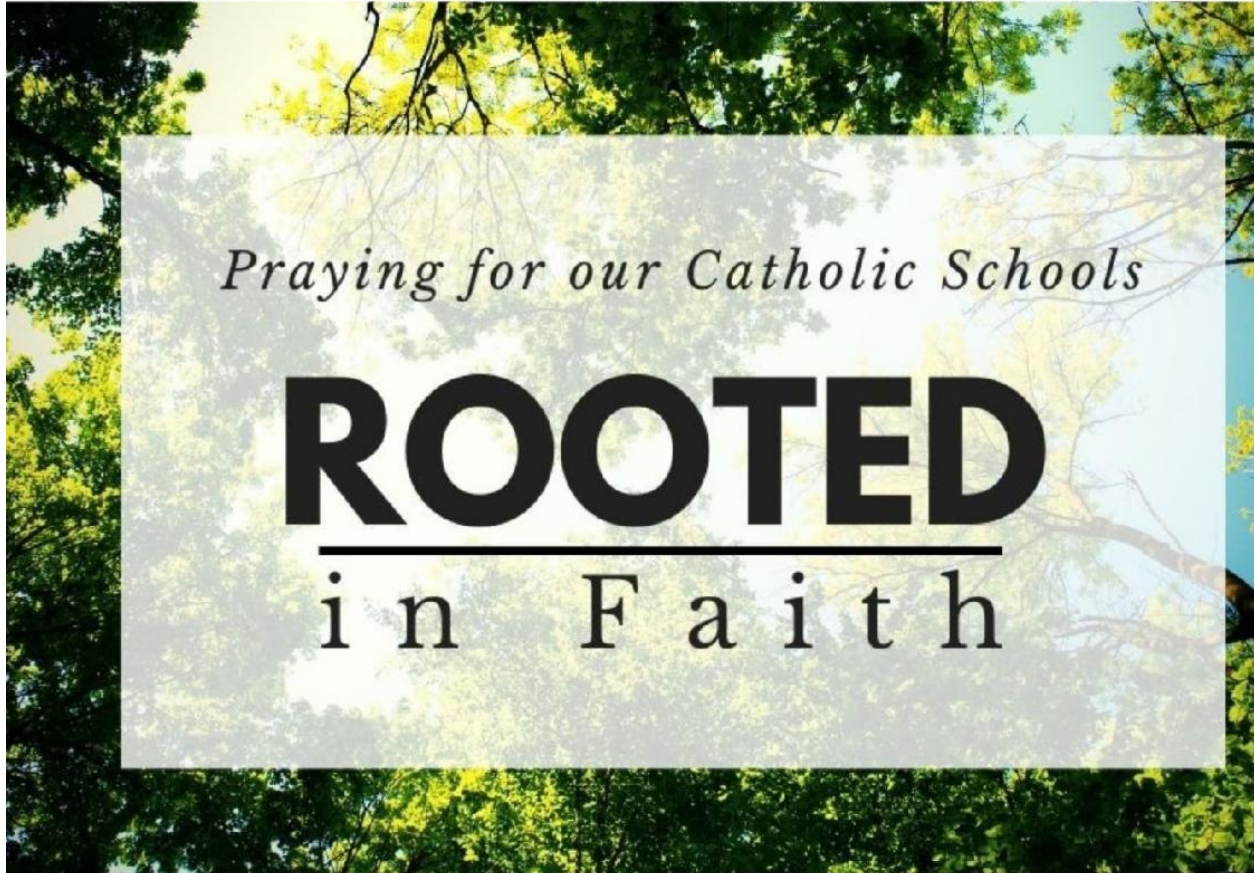
